## **Randal R. Bangert Elected Secretary/Treasurer of The Conference**

Williamsburg, VA – Randal R. Bangert, was elected as Secretary and Treasurer of The International Conference of Funeral Service Examining Boards at the 105th annual convention held February 26-27, 2009, in Williamsburg, Virginia.

Mr. Bangert was elected to serve on the Board of Directors of The International Conference of Funeral Service Examining Boards as Director of District 6 in 2005. As District 6 Director, Bangert represents the funeral service regulatory boards of Iowa, Kansas, Minnesota, Nebraska, North Dakota, South Dakota, Wisconsin, and Manitoba.

Mr. Bangert was appointed to serve as a public member on the Nebraska State Board of Funeral Directing and Embalming in 2005. Since that time he has achieved many accomplishments as a public member. In December, 2008, Bangert was elected Vice Chair of the Nebraska State Board. He is currently in his first term and will be eligible for reappointment in December, 2010.

Bangert is a retired police officer from the Lincoln Police Department after 28 years of service. He worked in various positions within the Department to include Narcotics investigator, and field training officer and served on a number of Department committees. He is the recipient of the Department's lifesaving award and a number of commendations for outstanding service.

Bangert graduated from Doane College in Crete, Nebraska, with a bachelor's degree in business administration and a master's degree in management. He is a retired major in the Nebraska Army National Guard and U.S. Army Reserve, and is also a licensed commercial helicopter and multi-engine commercial pilot with over 1,800 flying hours. Bangert currently works as the motorcoach supervisor and personal assistant to NASCAR Sprint Cup driver Brian Vickers.
